To lead the security assurance function, supporting the Group IT Director Information Security in providing confidence to the organisation that information security risks are effectively managed and controlled. I provide oversight, challenge and evidence-based assurance that security policies, standards and frameworks are embedded and operating as intended across services, projects and third-party arrangements.

I am accountable for the development and delivery of a risk-based security assurance programme, including control assessments, compliance reviews, audits and security input to governance processes. I work closely with internal teams and external partners to assess security posture, identifying gaps, ensuring assurance activity is pragmatic, consistent and aligned to organisational priorities and risk appetites.

I coordinate with Internal Audit colleagues in the Risk Directorate to align with their assurance activities. I liaise with the Head of Information Security, Risk and Compliance on framework compliancy, policy creation and risk management and with the Security Operations Manager on incident response and vulnerability management matters.

By maintaining awareness of regulatory expectations, sector practice and emerging assurance approaches, I ensure the organisation's security assurance capability continues to mature and add value. As part of the wider technology leadership community, I role-model a collaborative and accountable culture, supporting delivery excellence, transparency and shared ownership of security outcomes.

My skills and experience include:

I have extensive assurance and information security skills and experience. This involves completing security control assessments, framework compliance reviews and audits.

My knowledge and experience includes information security frameworks including NIST, CIS and ISO27k.

I have excellent communication skills and am able to liaise with stakeholders at all levels. I am able to support and influence technical colleagues to adhere to standards set out in policies and frameworks.
