I supervise the use of all equipment used by my team of arborists, helping maintain data quality relevant to compliance. I work with the Arboriculture Coordinator to create work schedules that maximise efficiency based on my knowledge of the resource available to me.

My skills and experience include:

I have excellent professional communication skills, and the ability to prioritise tasks in a dynamic environment..

I have good understanding of the application of BS:3998 and other recognised arboricultural standards, including AFAG/FISA, PUWER, LOLER and compliance with TPO & Conservation Area regs.

I have a full driving licence and experience towing up to 7t GTW.

I hold my PTI, which I can use to thoroughly assess trees that I may be called out to on an emergency basis.

I have industry related qualifications and appropriate experience in pruning, dismantling, MEWP's, and arb related machinery. Ideally I have SWQR Supervisor and FA+F, though these are not essential.

I am competent and confident in the use of digital devices.

The skills I will develop include:

Understanding and responding to any safeguarding and situations that occur on-site.

Understanding and familiarity with a range of software including work scheduling, data collection and GIS.
